
What is the difference between an ethnic group and a religious group?

Examples of ethnic groups ...




Berbers of North Africa



Let's look at some groups of the Middle East


KURDS





Spread across remote sections of Turkey, Iran, Syria and Iraqcollectively these regions are called **Kurdistan**


Most are **Sunni Muslims**, however, those in Iran are Shiite

- Speak Arabic




PERSIANS

- Live in Iran
- speak the Persian language
 - One of the oldest languages still spoken today!



Persia was the official name of Iran until 1935.



migrated to this area from Central Asia and later formed the great Persian Empire

Today, most Persians live in Iran...



and most are Shi'ite Muslims.

Ethnic Groups of Africa





- Live in central Ghana
- Religion –



- spiritual and supernatural powers
- Plants, animals, and trees have souls (animist)
- Believe in fairies, witches, and forest monsters





- Central and southern Africa
- Made up of hundreds of smaller ethnic groups such as the Zulu and Kikuyu
- Swahili the most common language
- Religion differs with region ...
- example
 - Bantu of Somalia are Islamic ...
 - Bantu of Kenya are Christian
 - Some Bantu are animist (belief that natural objects have souls)

Swahili

- Found mostly in eastern region of Africa
- Swahili language mix of Arabic and Bantu
- Religion Islam
